The most common type of compression fracture is a wedge fracture, in which the front of the vertebral body collapses but the back does not, meaning that the bone assumes a wedge shape. Sometimes, more than one vertebra fractures, a condition called multiple compression fractures.

Recovery time also depends on how bad the fracture is and can take from four to six months to heal. Fifth Metatarsal Fracture Surgery - AOFAS The base of the fifth metatarsal is divided into three fracture zones. Zone 1 fractures are avulsion or "chip" fractures that occur at the tip of the base of the fifth metatarsal. These fractures are typically treated without surgery using a cast, boot or hard-soled shoe. These fractures tend to heal within six to eight weeks.
